

Abacus Arts - Covid19 virus related actions

Abacus Arts are implementing the following Covid19 related actions in support of their users.

1 If the premises have been in use during 3 days prior to a booking

Then the following items will have been sanitised by spray or wiping:

- door handles and push plates,
- lighting switches, and heating controls,
- tap handles in kitchen and toilets.

Users shall be responsible to apply additional precautions appropriate to their use of the premises.

2 If the premises have been unoccupied for 3 days prior to a booking

Then no special sanitising actions will be applied, based on published guidance¹ This article reports that the virus may survive for up to 3 hrs in air, and up to 3 days on hard surfaces such as plastic and metal.

3 Social spacing options

Users shall make their own estimates based on the type of use envisaged. A detailed floor plan may be viewed and downloaded from the Abacus Arts website.

The following information is provided as an indication, based on Gov Guidelines available at 20nov20. The recommended spacing distances are;

2m where possible

OR

1m with extra precautions such as, face mask, or ventilation indoors.

3.1 Main rehearsal space

The approximate space is 11mx10m which indicates an occupancy level of

16 to 20 persons with basic 2m spacing.

More when the extractor fan² is running and/or masks are in use.

3.2 Kitchen / Breakout]

The approximate space is 4mx4m which indicates an occupancy level of

4 to 6 persons with basic 2m spacing.

More when the extractor fan³ is running and/or masks are in use.

2 The air extraction fan for the main space can be used at any time to draw fresh air into the RH corner of the mirror wall. The fan is quiet with a speed adjustment. At full capacity it pumps 1440m³/hr to provide around 4 changes of air in the main space every hour.

3 This is a normal Kitchen fume extractor and can be noisy.
